## Gutter Repair at clubhouse:

• Work was completed for clearing and covering

## Beach Reclamation:

- The project is complete.
- Noted that GIIA should budget for some new sand each year
  - Needs 3-5,000 metric tons per year estimate
  - Wait until fall to see the status before planning further

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

#### Beach Status Discussion:

- Noted that soil retention may need repair in some areas.
- The groin near the ramp wall needs to be monitored.
- The other ramp wall still needs to be repaired; tabling until financials are confirmed.
- A trash can recently floated away and was set to be recovered.
  - In the future, the can will need to be hooked to a pole nearby.
- Plants growing near the beach point are becoming invasive and need controlling.
- Potty was delivered in April, and services are being started for the season.
- The old post near the bench also needs removal.
- Jack reports a green table is very rusty in the swim beach area.
  - We may need some new tables at \$700-800 each.

#### Landscaping:

- Yvonne emailed the board the contract inclusions for landscapers.
- Some estimates were received and will be shared with the board.
- Someone with certifications for spray and such are preferred.

## **Capital Planning Committee:**

## Drainage issues in Walnut/Pinecrest/Beach areas:

- Some plat drawings were provided and reviewed by the group, seeking property lines for trees and other markers.
- It does not appear that trees causing concern are on community property. Several appear to be on another resident's land. This is tentative information.
- More discussions and decisions will be necessary. Grants are again suggested.

## Miscellaneous Topics:

- Rain drainage around the clubhouse area. Noted that the topography of the northern side leads water near downstairs doors. A drain of some sort is suggested.
  - Deb W. will look into gutter extensions to help ease the flows.
  - Recent gutter cleaning and covers will certainly help.
- AA County Dumpster date is set for August 12-14.
- Christina will get estimates of crushed rock renewal in the clubhouse parking lot.
- Yvonne and Brendan again suggest the idea of Boat Safety Checks for Glen Isle
  - Suggest a date in May or June; weekends or weekdays are possible.
  - Free of charge by Coast Guard Boat Aux.
