# Shoreline reclamation:

- John says the comment period is closed now. Need to check status
- \$35-40k estimate for all things \$8,500 for each groin, \$22K for sand (labor and all transport)
- Need more estimates. Only one for now.

# Beach Issues:

- Jack reports electrician for the pier is coming soon, he will coordinate.
- Jack asks if we can control grass on the swim beach as we are losing area rapidly.

- Question to confirm port-a-potty and trash pick-up days are on Thursdays.
- Discussion about a platform underneath the port-a-potty to stabilize.
- Jack offers to handle the many beach tasks if he can be considered the Beach Chair.
- Short discussion and a vote is held to name Jack Thibodeau the new Beach Chair.

#### APPROVED

- Idea shared for a volunteer work party date to ask for help with beach matters.
- Jack requests approval of a budget to take care of multiple issues, including those listed above, as well as general beach improvement and help.
- John S. makes a motion to approve \$2,500 for the new Beach Chair to complete beach repairs and improvements for 2023 projects. Dave S. seconds. Discussion. APPROVED
- Status check on the 6-mile per hour South River talk. Nothing further has been shared.
- Many non-residents at the beach on weekends. Residents are asked to follow rules for parking, gate keys, launches, and all else.

#### Swim Nets:

- We will need to purchase some new nets and heavier duty zip ties to connect them.
- Several issues led to a less than stellar season this year.
- We need an extraction, storage, and installation system designed and communicated for the future.
- Jellyfish will continue to be bad this summer.
- Leave nets until fall, replace in spring

# A Pier Redecking:

- The project cost is still uncertain and will also entail some plumbing and electrical updates to bring all up to code.
- The former estimate is a bit out of date (was combined with B-Pier bid).
- Rick N. will reach out to Bruce Builders for a new estimate.

# Clubhouse Committee:

- Christina reports interior painting estimates happening this week.
- Also need to get a handyman in for the garbage screening area outside, and other misc.
- Need some money authorized up front perhaps for small tasks. Dave S. had \$500 OK'd in June.
- Dave S. reports his lead on handman didn't pan out yet.
- Committee will work more on issues of concern.

# NEW BUSINESS:

# Bank Statements:

- JP requests a visual of the original bank statements at a future GIIA meeting.
- Just covering all bases by ensuring letterhead and such are in order.
- Cites recent incidents and Boards that had troubles.
- Yvonne has no issue with the request.

# Miscellaneous Topics:

- Dave S reports that the new trash company is finally able to service his street, citing that old servicer would not.
- Yvonne notes the Statewide Septic billing issue with port-a-potty.
- It is noted that the RVFD held recent pumping tests at the GI Beach and all went well.
- Elections in September. Reviewed seats on ballot and must confirm those running.
- Shared news that long-time officer Sam Liff will not be seeking re-election.
